**TEARFUND** invites you and your church to join them in prayer on Sunday, 24 November to pray for Tearfund's team at the UN Environmental Programme's

Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee INC-5.

The fifth round of negotiations (INC-5) will begin on Monday, 25 November, aiming to secure an ambitious, global, and legally-binding **plastic treaty** to bring an end to plastic pollution. This treaty is an opportunity to demonstrate this love and care in our efforts to fight for change. For over two years, Tearfund has been working on advocating for a strong treaty that will, in particular, help protect people living in poverty and waste pickers.

As Christians, we are called to love God's creation and to care for our global neighbours. Together, let's ask God to guide world leaders as they work to secure an ambitious plastic treaty — an opportunity we may never see again.
